

Material The Bliss collection consists of items with so called 'bone inlay'. It's an old decorative technique which uses small pieces of hand cut (or sawn) bone, that are glued on a underlay and covered with a black resin. After drying it is evenly polished down to where the bone becomes visible again, creating these beautiful motives.

Because this is a completely manual process every product is unique and the motives of the inlay can differ from the product photos.

The Bliss collection is a sophisticated combination of black/white and matt golden details and/or bases.

The bone that is processed comes from camels who died a natural death. It's cleaned and carefully polished by hand. Bone is a natural product and can therefore have minor colour deviations from the photos.

Maintenance Just like everything you take good care of and want to keep beautiful, Bliss also requires maintenance.

It is sufficient to wipe the furniture with a dry, clean (preferably cotton) cloth.

Cleaning products contain harmful bleach ingredients and chemicals that can damage the bone insert; please avoid using it. Both very high and very low temperatures can cause deformations in the furniture. The wood, resin or bone can expand or contract with damage as a result.

Bone tends to get a more yellowish colour over time. To avoid this, it is important to keep the furniture in the sunlight. Extreme heat from sunlight however may cause damage.

If you keep the above in mind, you will enjoy your Bliss furniture for a long time.
